

BLANDFORD GOLF CLUB FOOD SERVICES

Description of Establishment:

The Blandford Club is a golf and tennis club (www.massgolftennis.com) with approximately 150 members with three dining facilities including a banquet room, a luncheonette and a seated dining area; seating approximately 80, 12, and 28 respectively, and a basic kitchen with the essential components. A \$50 food credit is part of the membership fee.

There are many regularly scheduled events and special occasions which require food service and also opportunities to provide dining experiences to the community. Members and non-members also host private parties for special occasions e.g. birthdays, funerals and weddings, etc. which require food service.

Following is a list of events with approximate 2014 attendance:

Regularly Scheduled Events:

Ladies Golf weekly on Thursdays – Lunch for approximately 15
Junior Golf weekly on Tuesdays – Kids menu for approximately 20
Nine and Dine weekly on Tuesdays – Dinner for approximately 24
Men’s Golf Leagues weekly on Friday afternoon and evenings. In 2014, lunch was not provided, however in previous years, approximately 8-12 would have lunch. A buffet dinner was served to approximately 20 Friday night league players and other non-members in the community.
All lunches and dinners with the exception of Tuesday Nine and Dine are open to the public.

Special Events:

Welcome Back Party – dinner for approximately 45
July 4th Party – dinner for approximately 45
Annual meeting: Brunch for approximately 45
Round Robin Tournament – Coffee and donuts, lunch and dinner for approximately 20
Northampton Golf Tournament: Coffee and donuts and dinner for approximately 40
Memorial Tournament: Dinner for approximately 60
Special Occasions – 1-3 per season for over 50 people

Community Dining:

Lunch served – Tuesday, Thursday, Friday, Saturday – approximately 12
Friday buffet dinner in banquet facility - approximately 20
Saturday seated dining in parlor – approximately 20
Sunday Brunch – approximately 20

Type of Cuisine:

Four basic types of menus should be provided – Lunch, Buffet Dinners, Seated Dining

(with menu) and Sunday Brunch, Lunch. Suggestions below can be modified, more detailed and finalized with the candidate.

Lunch:

Sandwiches, hot dogs, hamburgers, grilled cheese, salads, chips.

Buffet Dinners:

Salad, Choice of 2 – meat, chicken or fish; Starch, Vegetables, Dessert - \$12 (one meat) or \$15 (two meats)

Seated Dining:

Salad, Three to four entrees, Starch, Vegetables, Dessert – (from menu) - Fixed price \$17

Sunday Brunch:

Continental breakfasts, full breakfast including eggs, omelets, waffles/pancakes, potatoes, toast, etc. - \$8 – 12

The Blandford Club does not have a liquor license, but will charge a corkage fee for wine. If there is waitress/waiter service, tipping is expected, otherwise there is a flat charge for food service. All food will be paid by food credits or credit card.

Job Title: Independent Contractor to provide food service

Duties:

Following are duties, requirements and responsibilities

- Plan and propose menus to Concessionaire Manager
- Hire waiter/waitress staff
- Responsible for procurement and preparation of food
- Maintain a sanitary kitchen and overall clean environment in eating facilities
- Execute concessionaire contract
- Computer tracking of revenues

Qualifications:

- Must be a certified licensed food provider
- Must demonstrate an in-force General Liability policy
- Provide resume and references
- Ability to propose menus suitable to the membership
- Ability to prepare meals quickly
- Ability to procure proper amounts of food and minimize waste
- The applicant will be accompanied by another person who could assist in providing the food service
- Flexibility for late comers and no-shows for scheduled events

Days and Hours:

Food will be served a total of 25 hours per week. Additional time will be required to procure and prepare food and clean-up.

- Tuesday 11am – 2pm, 5pm – 8pm – 6 hours
- Thursday 11 am – 2 pm – 3 hours
- Friday 11am – 2pm, 5pm – 8pm – 6 hours
- Saturday 11 am – 2pm, 6pm – 9pm – 6 hours
- Sunday 9 am – 1 pm – 4 hours
