VISIONS VCB SUMMER 2017 POSITIONS, QUALIFICATIONS, SALARIES

Program Coordinator /Supervisor

Supervise dorm and program activities manage meal service. Social work, special education, health, human services, rehabilitation or related experience required. (Masters level students and graduates are encouraged to apply.) Supervisory/management experiences a must. (Must be 24+ yrs)

Salary: Program Coord. \$3400, Supervisor \$2685 for full 6 weeks (4 weeks available as well).

Dining Hall Manager

Manage meal service and oversee dining operation for 3 meals a day. Culinary art, business administration, Social work, health, human services, rehabilitation or related experience required. (Masters level students and graduates are encouraged to apply.)

Supervisory/management experiences a must. (Must be 24+ yrs.)

Salary: Dining Hall Mngr\$2685 for full 6 weeks (4 weeks are available as well).

Program Specialist/Artist in Residence

Plan and facilitate program, e.g. Arts (Crafts, Pottery, Music, Dance, etc.), Fitness (Must have Certification), Education (Adaptive Computers, Nature, etc.) Must have program expertise and experience facilitating groups. (Must be 21+ yrs)

Salary is \$2375 for full 6 weeks commitment, or a range of \$480 - \$850 per session

Professional Staff

Certified Vision Rehabilitation Therapist (CVRT), Certified Orientation and Mobility Specialist (COMS), Occupational Therapist (OTRL), Teacher of the Visually Impaired (TVI), Early Intervention Specialists (EI), Para Professionals/Teacher's Aides, etc. Experience with special populations.

Salary: Full summer negotiable (7-day session = \$1,000/Professional; \$500/Para Professional)

Counselor

Provide assistance with program activities, meal service and in dormitories. Outgoing, warm, committed and interested in working with people of all ages who are blind. Maturity, enthusiasm, creativity and motivation a must. (Must be 18+ yrs.)

Salary is \$1910 for full 6 weeks commitment, or a range of \$390 - \$685 per session

Dining Hall Staff

Serve and clean up for meals, assist with program activities when assigned. Ability to work as part of a team. Demonstrate flexibility. (Must be 18+ yrs).

Salary is \$1910 for full 6 weeks commitment, or a range of \$390 - \$685 per session

Maintenance Assistant/Porter

Clean dormitories, program areas, and bathrooms; grounds work; carry luggage; assist with program activities when assigned. Some heavy lifting. Must be flexible. (Must be 18+ yrs.)

Salary is \$2375 for full 6 weeks summer, or \$1830 for a 4 week min. commitment

We are now accepting staff applications for VCB summer 2017. One week, two week or full six week summer positions are available. VISIONS/Services for the Blind and Visually Impaired operates a residential vision rehabilitation and training center, VISIONS Center on Blindness (VCB), in Spring Valley, New York. The center serves 600 blind people each year, including a diverse population of adults, elders, teens, and families with blind children.

VCB offers a stimulating outdoor residential work experience that provides ideal training for careers in social work, special education, rehabilitation, therapeutic recreation, occupational therapy, physical therapy and other health and human service fields. VISIONS staff are available to work with students and faculty to arrange internships and cooperative education opportunities.

VISIONS is an equal opportunity employer. No previous experience working with people who are blind is required, although it is valued. Training and professional supervision are provided at VCB. Reasonable accommodations are made for people with disabilities. Qualities we look for in applicants include: maturity, initiative, commitment to offer service to others, creativity, and an ability to work as part of a diverse staff team and accept constructive supervision.
